



Oddgeir Synnes (NORWAY)

Oddgeir Synnes is Professor of Health Humanities at VID Specialized University in Oslo, Norway. Synnes is a literary scholar and has for many years worked with uses of literature and creative writing in later life and in health care contexts. He has led numerous courses in creative among older adults, including at municipal libraries, in nursing homes and in dementia care. He has also worked with creative writing in mental health and in end-of-life care. His PhD comprises an analysis of poems and stories from creative writing in palliative care. Synnes has published extensively on various forms of storytelling and writing in the mentioned contexts. His latest book is *A Poetic Language of Ageing* (with Olga V. Lehmann – Bloomsbury Academic, 2023).
